Professor or Associate Professor of Global Health

The Global Health Insitute (GHI) within the University of Georgia (UGA) College of Public Health (CPH) welcomes nominations and applications for a faculty position at the rank of Professor or Associate Professor with tenure. The applicant must have maintained research programs in global health with extramural funding and demonstrate long-term affiliations with international academic institutions, health organizations, and/or other foundations involved in global public health. A doctoral degree is required, either a PhD in public health or global health, or in a health-related field, or in a biomedical discipline. Holders of a DrPH, MD, DO or DVM are also eligible if they have a minimum of five years experience in at least one of the five core public health disciplines: biostatistics, environmental health, epidemiology, health promotion and behavior or health policy and management.

Applicants must also demonstrate successful scholarship, instruction and leadership in their field. Accomplishments to be considered include sustained research in global health, global health field projects, mature international research collaborations, publications in prominent scientific journals, and mentorship of graduate students and early career faculty in global health.
